Component 1- Construction of a new electricity generating power plant

ELECTRICITE DE DJIBOUTI (EDD) is an Industrial and Commercial public authority handling the generation, transmission and distribution of electricity within the Republic of Djibouti. The present Call for Tender is issued by the EDD to invite bidders with the appropriate capability to submit a bid, in a sealed envelope, for:

The “turnkey” construction of a new electricity generating power plant, with a final installed electrical power output of around 100 MW, under the climatic conditions of Damerjog site which is located on the suburb of the city of Djibouti.

This project is constituted two sections :

- o The **section 1** = the construction of a power plant with a total net installed capacity of 50 MWe (6/7 identical 9-10 MWe generators) equipped with all the facilities and common equipments to enable expansion to 100 MWe: civil engineering, structural work, finishing work on all structures, foundations, various installations, and common electromechanical and electrical equipments of the power plant.
- o The **section 2** = the supply, transport, installation, commissioning, and acceptance of additional equipments for a final power output of 100 MWe for the power plant, i.e., 6/7 identical generator sets (engines + auxiliaries) with a unit power output of 9-10 MWe.

The call for tender documents, in English, are available on a USB key, for bidders duly identified as follows:

- **Either directly at the Electricité de Djibouti registered office**, boulevard de la République (Djibouti city), against payment by certified cheque, drawn on a major bank, in favour of the EDD accountant in the sum of **200 000 (two hundred thousand) FDJ**,
- **Or by written application to Electricité de Djibouti, BP 175 DJIBOUTI (Republic of Djibouti)**, with proof of an international credit transfer in favour of the EDD account in the sum of **1 200 (one thousand two hundred) USD**. EDD will forward the Call for Tender documents.

Call for Tender documents handed over locally, in Djibouti, should be paid:

- either by **certified CHEQUE**, drawn on a major bank, in favour of ELECTRICITE de DJIBOUTI,
- or in **Cash**, a receipt for which will be issued by the **ELECTRICITE de DJIBOUTI accountant**.

Bidders for the present call for tender must meet the following main requirements:

a/ The bidder shall be:

- **A Reputable Manufacturer of Diesel Engines** of the required rating. In the case of a manufacturer producing the required type of engine under licence, the said manufacturer shall submit, with the tender, an OEM certification confirming authorization, compliance with standards, and access to original parts.

Or

- **Turnkey EPC contractors**, with:
 - demonstrated experience in designing, construction, and commissioning of power plants.
 - at least three (3) similar turnkey projects in the past five (5) years, with individual project capacities exceeding 20 MW.
 - The proposed Diesel engine manufacturer must meet the technical requirements and shall be evaluated based on the criteria listed in the call of tender.
 - The contractor must provide a letter of commitment from the diesel engine manufacturer confirming full technical support and warranty obligations for the project as per requirements included in the call of tender.

Or

- **Joint Ventures (JV) or Consortia :**
 - The Joint Venture (JV) or consortium must submit a formal joint undertaking, that explicitly confirms all members accept joint and several liability for the performance and completion of the entire project, as required under the Employer requirements.
 - The lead partner within the JV or consortium must demonstrate relevant experience by having successfully completed at least one EPC/turnkey project of a similar scale, scope, and complexity. This is crucial to ensure that the lead partner possesses the necessary technical and managerial expertise to oversee the project.
 - Each member of the JV or consortium must meet the eligibility criteria that correspond to their respective roles and responsibilities within the project. These criteria ensure that all members are suitably qualified and capable of fulfilling their obligations under the contract.

b / All Goods, materials and equipment procured under this Contract shall originate from countries that comply with the Financiers' procurement regulations. In particular:

- The procurement of Goods and services shall not involve any country, entity, or supplier subject to boycott regulations imposed by the League of Arab States or the Organization of Islamic Cooperation.
- The Contractor shall ensure that no Goods or materials originate from, or are supplied by, entities or persons subject to such restrictions.
- The Contractor shall obtain and submit certificates of origin and supplier declarations confirming compliance with these requirements.

c / The bidder shall notably substantiate:

- **Audited financial statements for the last three (3) years demonstrating an average annual turnover of at least USD 60 million.**
- Proof of an existing line of credit worth USD 20 million from a recognized international bank.

d/ The bidder shall provide :

- Documentation of at least three (3) completed turnkey power plant projects in the past five (5) years, with a minimum capacity of 20 MW.
- Reference letters from clients confirming successful project completion.

e/ The bidder shall remit a bid guarantee of 2 000 000 USD (two million US dollars).

f/ *The remaining technical and commercial requirements are specified in the various documents of the present call for tenders.*

Tenderer is obliged to submit all the following formats before or on the Submission Date and in case of any discrepancy, the original documents will prevail.

- The original and all copies must be typewritten or written in indelible ink (photocopies are acceptable for the copies) and signed by the person(s) duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Tenderer.

2. *Digital Submission:*

- One USB key containing an electronic copy of Envelope 1 only.
- One USB key containing an electronic copy of Envelope 2 only.

B / Latest date for reception of bids

- The Works Owner must receive the bids, at the above-mentioned address, not later than **Wednesday, JUNE 17, 2026, before 8 a.m. local time.**
- The Works Owner may, at its own discretion, extend the period and the latest date for the reception of bids by publishing an amendment. In such a case, all the rights and obligations of both the Works Owner and the bidder that were previously governed by the initial date limit, will be subject to the new date limit.
- Any bid received by the Works Owner after the specified latest date will be returned unopened to the bidder.
